Please, be informed that on 24th November 2011 Borika-Bankservice AD has taken a decision to issue new time and status root certificates regarding the changes in Electronic Document and Electronic Signature Act dated 1st July 2011 and related to this effective legislation, as well as the expiry of the current operational B-trust certificates for time and status.

- The above-mentioned does not change the validity of the digital documents and signatures you have already received.
- If the documents issued after 24th November 2011 are not validated correctly, it is necessary to install the new time and status certificates of B-trust
